

#### **FOLLOWERS OF JESUS**

Two brothers, Harry and James, finished supper and were playing until bedtime. Somehow, Harry hit James with a stick, and tears along with bitter words followed. Charges and accusations were still being exchanged as mother prepared them for bed.

The mother instructed, "Now, James, before you go to bed you're going to have to forgive your brother." James was thoughtful for a few moments, and then replied, "Well, OK, I'll forgive him tonight, but if I don't die before I wake up, he'd better look out in the morning." We smile because we can really relate to James. But Jesus made clear that we cannot forgive someone while continuing to nurse a grudge.

So far, we have learned two principles from the Lord's Sermon on the Mount. First, in Matthew 5 we discovered that kingdom righteousness is internal (unseen heart) before it can be external (seen deeds). Second, in Matthew 6 we learned that the primary motive of kingdom righteousness is before God (private) rather than before others (public).

This Sunday I will conclude this series of messages with a third truth from Jesus. Why is this important? We are followers of Jesus.

GETTING STARTED - we will have more of everything available this week.

- Take a box
- Take a boy/girl label and information sheet.

#### FILLING IT

- Use the sheets provided to guide you with what to buy, and not to buy.
- Consider enclosing a personal note and photo.
- PRAY for the child who will receive your box.
- Mark and then tape the boy/girl label on specified place on box.

## TURNING IT IN

- Your filled box needs to be returned to FBC by Sunday, November 12.
- A donation of \$10 per box is needed to cover shipping/project costs. You or a friend you are sharing costs with can pay for that one of several ways:
  - 1) put an envelope containing the money inside the box OR
  - 2) donate online at SAMARITANSPURSE.ORG/OCC which allows you to use the "Follow Your Box" where you can also discover the destination of your shoebox. If you choose this method, please let Helen know. She wants to make sure each box is covered with the appropriate donation OR
  - 3) a note that your box still needs the \$10 donation.
