The Role of Usher at FBC

At FBC the role of usher is open to both men and women, around high school age and up. Before the church service starts, the ushers prepare the bulletins for distribution. As churchgoers arrive, ushers are the first representatives of Jesus, greeting each person with a smile, shaking hands, and handing out bulletins. They are also available to answer visitors’ questions, direct them to the Kids’ Time location, and extend extra help in seating anyone who needs assistance.

During the church service, the ushers help take up the church offering and then carry it back to the front. Ushers do not talk loudly or make a commotion at the back. Instead, they have a goal of minimizing distractions during the worship service. Ushers stand ready to assist anyone in the congregation who might need help, to aid latecomers in finding a seat, and to inform those in the sanctuary of any urgent medical or security issue.
