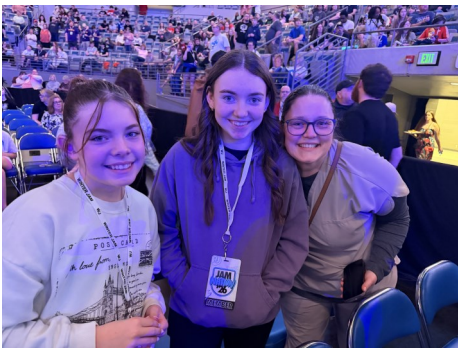

I want Congress to extend Temporary Protected Status to people from Haiti.
