

Whitewashing Sheep

People today are extremely concerned about offending others. As a result, tact has been replaced with dishonesty. Even careful diplomacy is now viewed as rudeness. Courageous frankness is considered disrespectful. Those who voice their honest perceptions are often labelled as thoughtless and stupid.

I smiled at this incident demonstrating how our society behaves.

The children of a prominent family decided to give their father a book of the family's history for a birthday present. They commissioned a professional biographer to do the work, carefully warning him of the family's 'black sheep' problem: Uncle George had been executed in the electric chair for murder. The biographer assured the children, "I can handle that situation so there is no embarrassment. I'll merely say that Uncle George occupied a chair of applied electronics at an important government institution. He was attached to his position by the strongest of ties and his death came as a real shock.

In contrast, Jesus was unwilling to whitewash the sheep. If I had been one of the religious leaders back in the first century, I doubt I would have smiled at this rebuke from the Lord.

"Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you are like whitewashed tombs, which outwardly appear beautiful, but within are full of dead people's bones and all uncleanness" (Mt. 23:27).

Yes, Jesus was "full of grace and truth" (Jn. 1:14). Seek to always respond like Him. Strive to be winsome and diplomatic. But keep on standing up for the truth. Refuse to be silenced by our increasingly dishonest "whitewash culture."
