Although it's not observed as a public holiday, this day is still important and there is so much to celebrate. This holiday even got its own episode on the television series "The Office."

During World War II there was a shortage of people with the skills of an administrative professional. This was due to the birth-rate decline from the Depression era and booming post-war business. In 1942, the National Secretaries Association was formed in order to recognize the contributions of administrative personnel to the economy, support their development, and attract workers to the field. During their first year as an association, they created National Secretaries Week.

In 1955, Secretaries Week was moved to the last full week of April, with Wednesday marked as Administrative Professionals Day. The day has undergone many name changes but the initial goal to celebrate and recognize all the hard work administrative professionals do has remained.

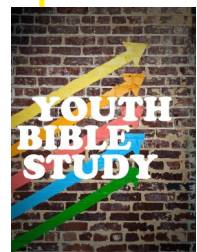
