


# Harry A. McFarren



Students connected with First Baptist Church who are pursuing post-high school education are invited to apply for a monetary scholarship for the 2019-2020 academic year. Please review the following criteria as approved by the church deacon board.

- Applicants must have attended FBC consistently for at least one year. (Such FBC connected students who have been unable to attend FBC while away at college may still apply).
- Deadline to submit a scholarship application by mail or in person is Sunday, June 30, 2019.
- Stop by or contact the church office in order to receive a scholarship application.
- The scholarship amount is \$1,500.00 per academic year.
- This scholarship is renewable. However, a new application must be submitted each year.
- Checks will be made out directly to the student's school to help offset educational expenses.
- Scholarships will be handed out to students in July.
