As a mother said goodbye to her son who was returning to school after summer break, she reminded him to write often. Another woman standing nearby heard the plea and gave this advice: "The surest way to get your son to write home is to send him a letter saying, 'Here's 50 dollars. Spend it any way you like." The mother replied, "And that will make my son write home?" The adviser said, "Yes indeed. Just forget to enclose the money."

What motivates you to get out of bed and get going each morning? On the topic of motivation, around A.D. 61 Paul wrote these penetrating words from a Roman prison cell: "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me" (Phil. 4:13). In a sermon back in January of 2013 I gave the following points. I gleaned some of these insights from a message by author John C. Maxwell.

"I can" – this is the **attitude** to win. Do you see people and life as trash or treasure? Your perspective determines if you see each day filled with obstacles or opportunities.

"do all things" – this is the **commitment** to win. Life's most important and strategic moments are won or lost in the arena of action. This brings to mind one of my favorite quotes: "When all is said and done, more is said than done."

"through Christ" – this is the **reason** to win. Paul faced several very difficult challenges. Yet, he found purpose and meaning each day through his relationship with the Lord Jesus.

"who strengthens me" – this is the **power** to win. The Holy Spirit can fill us and energize us. In the Lord's strength we can accomplish all God wants us to do.
